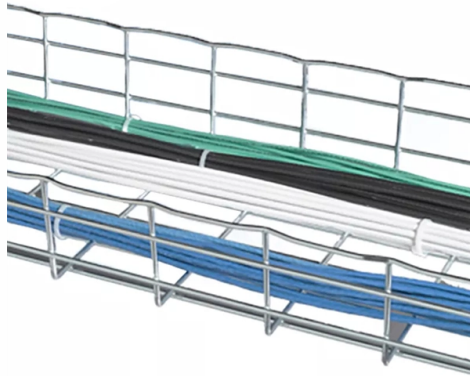


Standard for Installation Location of New Energy Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

New energy distribution boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible locations, typically at a height of 1.5–1.8 meters, with proper grounding and compliance with IEC, BS 7671, or local standards.

Site Selection and Environmental Requirements

Distribution boxes must be installed close to the power supply to minimize power loss and ensure safety, while avoiding humid, corrosive, or dusty environments that could damage equipment or reduce heat dissipation. For outdoor installations, the enclosure should meet IP or NEMA ratings appropriate for weather protection, such as IP54 or higher. The location should allow good ventilation to prevent overheating and provide sufficient clearance for maintenance and inspection.

Installation Height and Accessibility

The bottom edge of the distribution box is generally installed between 1.5 meters and 1.8 meters above the ground, which facilitates operation and inspection. For residential settings, a height of 1.3 meters is recommended for elderly or handicapped users. Industrial installations may require specific mounting areas with defined width, height, and depth limits to ensure safe access to components.

Fixing and Mounting

The distribution box should be firmly fixed using suitable brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or collision. The mounting surface must be stable, and the box should be level to maintain safety and operational reliability.
