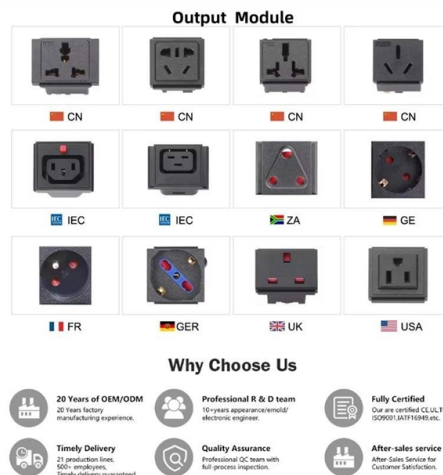


Standard thickness of reinforced cable trays



Article Overview

Reinforced cable trays typically have a material thickness ranging from 1.2 mm to over 3 mm, depending on load requirements, tray width, and environmental conditions.

Typical Thickness Ranges

- Light-duty trays: 1.2 mm to 1.5 mm, suitable for small control or instrumentation cables with minimal load requirements .
- Medium-duty trays: 1.5 mm to 2.5 mm, commonly used in commercial buildings and moderate industrial applications where power and data cables are routed together .
- Heavy-duty or reinforced trays: 2.5 mm and above, designed for large cable bundles, long support spans, or outdoor/corrosive environments. These trays often feature reinforced side rails to increase structural rigidity and reduce deflection under load .

Factors Affecting Thickness Selection

- Load Capacity: Thicker materials allow trays to support heavier cable loads and longer spans between supports without excessive bending .
- Tray Width and Depth: Wider or deeper trays generally require thicker material to maintain structural integrity .
