Overview

TNC Level 1 Distribution Boxes are stand-alone solutions for controlling and monitoring electrical devices such as fire dampers. For example, the TROX TNC-EC series can manage up to 12 fire dampers with 24 V actuators or 24 damper blade end positions, providing centralized control and monitoring in a single enclosure . These boxes typically include a switching power supply and are housed in sheet steel or stainless steel casings, often powder-coated for durability and corrosion resistance .

Construction and Materials

- Enclosure Material: Options include sheet steel, stainless steel, or polyester, depending on environmental requirements .
- Protection Ratings: Many TNC boxes meet IP66/IP67 or NEMA 4/4X standards, ensuring protection against dust, water, and mechanical stress .
- Temperature and Environmental Resistance: Designed to withstand extreme temperatures (e.g., -40°C to +200°C for silicone-sealed boxes) and corrosive environments such as chemical plants or marine applications .
- Cable Entries: Limited gland entries per side maintain mechanical stability, with options for quick locks or screw-only covers .
