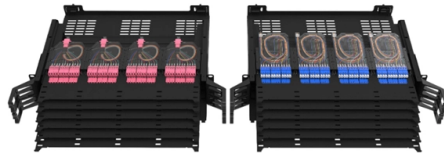


The wires in the cable tray are too hot
