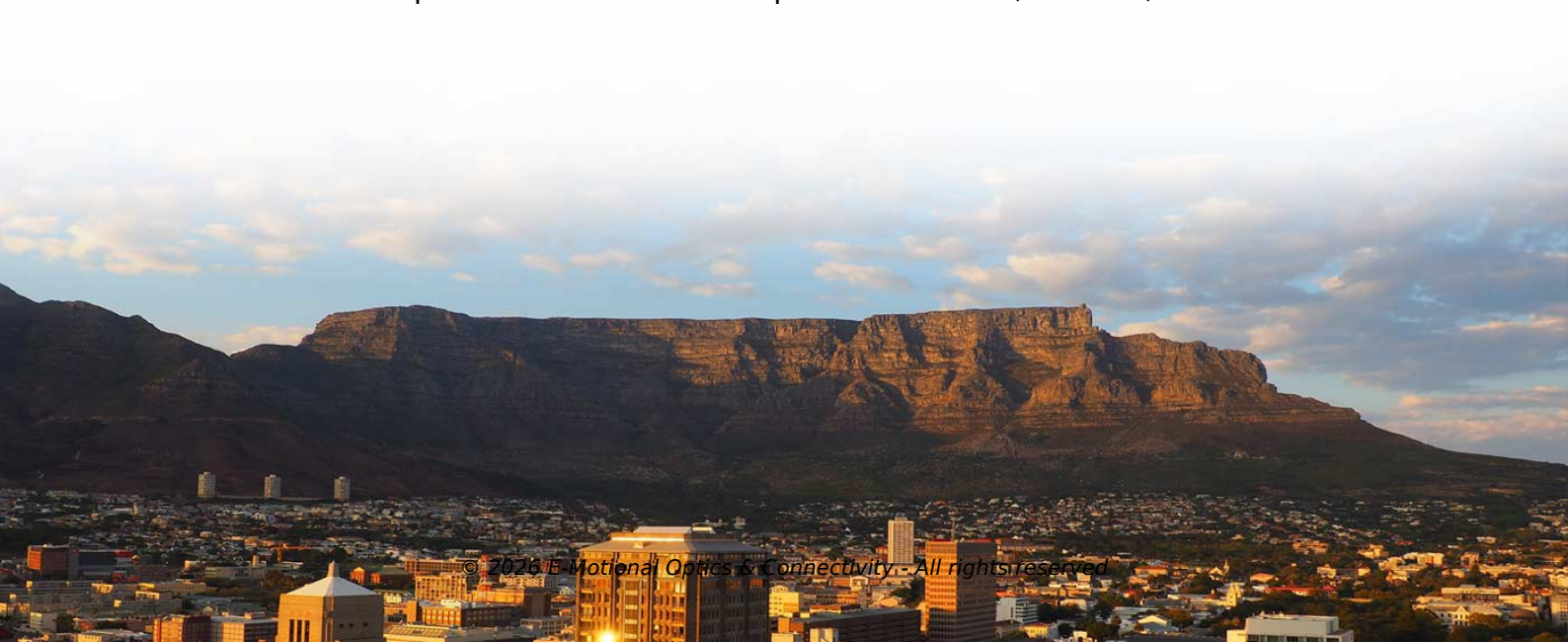


What cable width is required for the network cabinet
