

What does secondary distribution box refer to

A secondary distribution box, also called a sub-distribution panel, distributes electrical power from the main distribution panel to specific areas or buildings, typically handling three-phase power for equipment.

Definition and Function

A secondary distribution box serves as an intermediate panel in a power distribution system, positioned between the primary distribution box (main panel) and tertiary distribution boxes (final connection points for individual devices) (). Its primary function is to route electricity to specific zones, floors, or buildings, ensuring that power is delivered safely and efficiently to multiple circuits within a localized area ().

Typical Applications

- Construction sites: Provides power to different sections or floors of a project.
- Residential complexes: Supplies electricity to individual buildings from the main transformer.
- Commercial buildings: Distributes power to different floors or departments. By acting as a sub-panel, it allows for localized control, easier maintenance, and the addition of new circuits without overloading the main panel ().

Components and Features

Secondary distribution boxes generally include:

- Large three-phase circuit breakers to protect equipment and circuits.
