

What to do if the network rack power strip won't fit

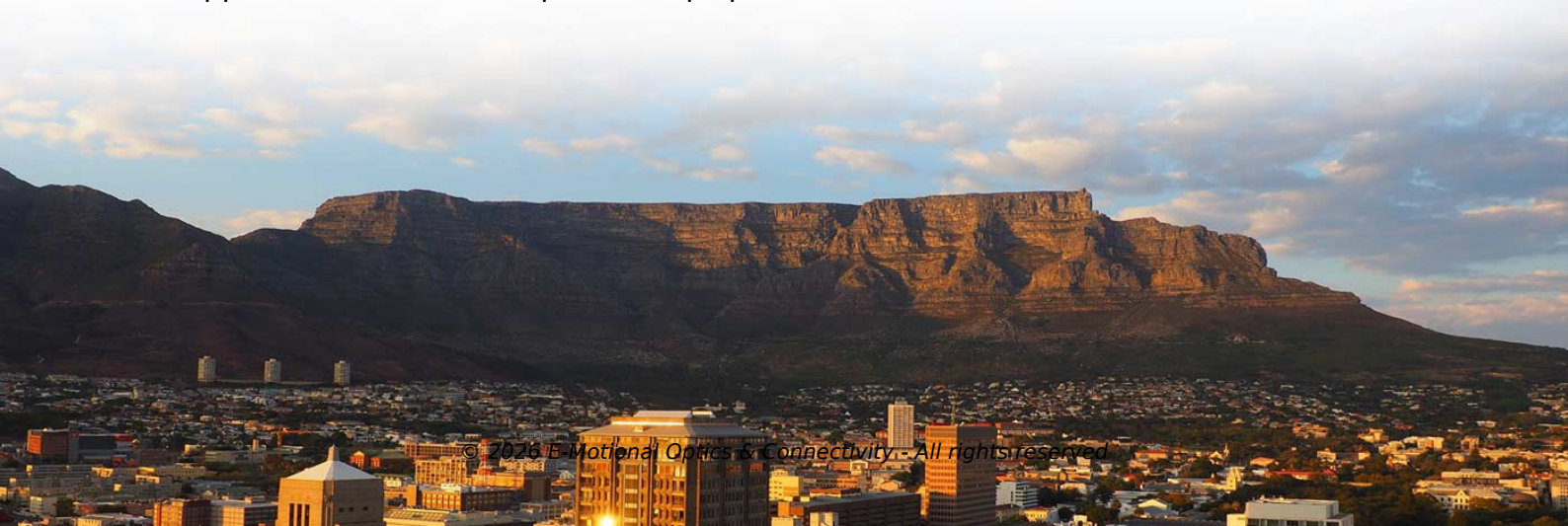
