Overview

Limited to Two Devices: A single splitter setup can only support two devices sharing the same cable. An Ethernet splitter doesn't actually split an Ethernet connection into two separate, functional network connections; instead, it leverages unused wires within an Ethernet cable to allow two devices to share the same physical cable, but significantly reducing network speed and often introducing. Instead of a splitter, you need an Ethernet switch to connect multiple devices to a single network connection. You may also want to know: Are Bing and Yahoo the Same?

The term “Ethernet splitter” often conjures up the image of a magical device that can instantly. When most people talk about an Ethernet cable splitter, they're usually referring to a small passive adapter, often called a passive RJ45 splitter.
