

Wireless panel that can connect to fiber optic cables



Article Overview

A wireless panel cannot connect directly to a fiber optic cable; it requires an intermediary device like an ONT or media converter to convert optical signals into electrical signals compatible with the panel.

How It Works

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light, which wireless panels and routers cannot interpret directly. To integrate a wireless panel into a fiber network, the optical signal must first be converted into an electrical signal. This is typically done using:

- **Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Provided by your ISP, the ONT converts the incoming fiber optic signal into Ethernet, which can then be connected to a wireless router or access point via a standard Ethernet cable .
- **Fiber Media Converter or SFP Modules:** In more advanced setups, a fiber media converter or SFP transceiver can convert fiber to copper Ethernet, allowing connection to wireless access points or switches .

Steps to Connect

- **Install the ONT or media converter:** Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT or media converter's designated port.
- **Connect to the wireless panel:** Use a Cat5e, Cat6, or higher Ethernet cable to link the ONT or converter to the wireless panel's LAN or WAN port.
